

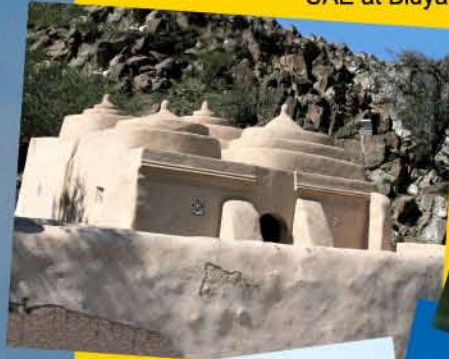
# majestic mangroves kalba

## Dates & Duration

Available year round. 4 hour round trip from Dibba or your east coast hotel.

## The Trip

This half day tour takes us to the oldest mosque in the UAE at Bidya, constructed more than 400 years ago,



then along the coast road to Fujairah with its impressive mud brick fort. The fort, once home to Fujairah's rulers, has recently been restored along with other important buildings. The original fort was completed in 1670 and consists of 3 major parts with several halls and towers.

We continue on to Khor Kalba situated a few kilometres south of Fujairah, close to the border with Oman. Here we find Arabia's oldest mangrove forest and the only known breeding ground for the endangered White Collared Kingfisher. We usually see several turtles swimming beneath us as we cross the small metal bridge.

We return via Masafi. If time permits we stop at Bithnah Fort. The fort, built in 1735 guards the strategic route through the Hajjar mountains in Wadi Ham.
